About the Topic and Presenter:

Dan Reed is the director and clinical associate professor for the General Practice Residency (GPR) at The Ohio State University College of Dentistry.

Dr. Reed received his Doctor of Dental Surgery degree from The Ohio State University College of Dentistry. He then completed a General Practice Residency at OSU that specializes in treating patients who are medically compromised and have disabilities. He was chosen to stay for a second year as chief resident. Upon completion of his program, he was immediately hired as a full-time faculty in the College of Dentistry. During this time, he has taught dental students, been clinical director of the GPR program and for the last 8 years as director of the program.

He has a passion for the “patients nobody else will see.” He employs patient education, oral sedation, IV sedation and general anesthesia as needed to treat his patient population.

In addition to his years of experience, Dr. Reed also has a son on the autism spectrum. His personal experiences have only enhanced his willingness to work with others to treat this population.
