The Parent Mentors for Dublin City Schools and the Special Education Advancement Council (SEAC) will host a presentation focused on setting up programs within your home that can help your family use a positive and supportive approach to successfully change behavior. Melinda Thurman, (MS, BCBA, COBA), a Behavior Support Specialist with Nisonger Center will help the attendees understand the following:

 - When should you seek outside assistance for problem behaviors?

- What are the functions of behaviors? How can families identify problem behaviors?
- What are some universal techniques that I can use at home to teach appropriate behaviors and prevent inappropriate ones in order to move forward towards behavioral change?
