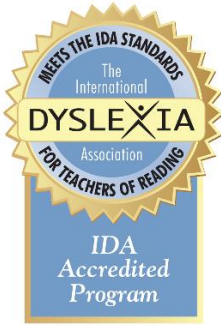


# THE ORTON-GILLINGHAM (O-G) APPROACH to TEACHING EARLY LITERACY SKILLS

In 1992, Dr. Andrist initiated and directed the Graduate Reading Programs at Notre Dame College (NDC), working with teachers from across Northern Ohio, including teachers in kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade in the Cleveland Municipal School District. She has trained 100s of teachers in literacy including Orton-Gillingham (O-G) multisensory structured literacy strategies

Dr. Andrist is a past president of the International Dyslexia Association (IDA) in Central Ohio and the former chair of the Ohio Board of Regents Task Force for Teacher Education in Dyslexia. She is currently the Co-Chair of Ohio IDA Executive Legislative Committee. She serves on the IDA program review and exam committees, and on the Executive Board of OCECD. Charlotte first brought Ron Yoshimoto to Ohio in the fall of 2012 to train teachers in the O-G structured literacy approach. She is an Internationally Certified Master Trainer in the Yoshimoto Approach and coordinates and conducts Yoshimoto Orton-Gillingham trainings in Ohio.

## **For whom is the O-G Early Literacy approach appropriate?**

The O-G pre-school training course is specially designed by Ron Yoshimoto for pre-school and kindergarten teachers who wish to use the Orton-Gillingham Approach in the early literacy component of their pre-school or kindergarten curriculum. The O-G Early Literacy program caters to all children, even those with literacy difficulties. This preschool/kindergarten training course focuses on practical, hands-on activities. During the 3-day course, teachers will learn to teach O-G early literacy skills using materials provided to them. Upon successful completion of the course, teachers will be able to provide a strong foundation of early literacy skills to all their students, including students who may be at-risk for reading failure.

**What:** The Orton-Gillingham (O-G) approach is an explicit, systematic multisensory structured language (MSL) teaching method for teaching reading, writing and spelling.
